We discuss these values regularly during our daily collective worship and they form the basis of our approach to behaviour. Staff regularly give out Gem Points to children showing these values to reinforce how important they are. The Welly Walk is normally one occasion where we see lots of evidence of children being compassionate and caring to each other particularly as they encourage those with little legs to keep going and enjoy the adventure!




FOWS AGM - time and venue TBC
